In answer to your letter of January 25 regarding the above wall: we appreciate the photographs that were submitted, and it is fairly obvious from these photographs that it would be impossible to put this wall the full 990' from the west line of the soction. In addition, Mr. Barnes, our geologist, has been in the area of the lesstion, and we realize the difficulty that would be encountered in complying to the letter of the regulation.

However, this well is within the boundaries of an established gas pool - namely, the Fulcher-Kutz Pictured Cliffe pool, and for this reason it will be necessary for you to present your case at a regular hearing for approval of this unorthodox location. As Byrd-Frost owns all the offset leases adjacent to this well, I don't believe there will be any difficulty whatsoever, and this is purely a matter of legal formality.

Since we already have the photographs, plat and Notice of Intention to Drill (Form G-101), it will only be necessary for you to make a formal application in triplicate requesting that this matter be placed before the Commission at the earliest possible date. Any member of your company can represent you at our hearings, and they entail no great expense, since the precoedings are quite informal. If you will return the formal application as soon as possible, we will place this case on the agends for the first hearing scheduled after we receive said application.

The preceding will apply also to your L. B. Ledewick No. 2, located in Sec. 18, T 27 N, 9 W.

We trust that our revision of Rule 104 will allow more floribility and remove the necessity for formal hearing in the future, but until revisions of this rule have been formally adapted by the Counission, it will be necessary to abide by the present swiing in this matter.
