#### Gentlemen:

I represent Mr. W. H. Ritchey, owner of the 40 acres to the North adjacent to the tract upon which the Commission approved the unorthodox location of Williams & Reed No. 6 State Well by its order dated October 15, 1951, this matter having been submitted to the Commission on August 21, 1951, taken under advisement and the order made on October 15, 1951.

As I understand the rules and regulations of the Commission, Petition for Rehearing must be filed within twenty days from the date of the order. Please file this petition, and I would appreciate your advising what action is taken by the Commission after its consideration of the same.


