ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing on October 23, 1951, at Santa Fe ,
New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico,
hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW on this 20th day of November, 1951, the Commission, a quorum
being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits
received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS, (1) That due public notice having been given as required by
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the persons and
subject matter thereof.

(2) That a new pool should be created and designated
as the East Caprock (Devonian) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, for
Devonian Production, described as:

Twp. 12 S., Rge. 32E., N.M.P.M.
Section 14, All;

to include Amerada Petroleum Corporation State EC "A" Well No. 1, and
other developments.

(3) That the Saunders (Permo-Pennsylvanian) Pool, Lea
County, New Mexico, as heretofore defined and described should be
extended to include:

Twp. 14S., Rge 33E., N.M.P.M.
Sec. 35, W/2;

Twp. 15S., Rge 33E., N.M.P.M.
Sec. 2, W/2;
Sec. 4, E/2;
Sec. 10, N/2;

to include Amerada Petroleum Corporation State S "D" Well No. 1, and
other developments.

(4) That the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore defined and described should be extended to include:

to include American Republics Corporation Yates State Well No. 5, and other developments.

(5) That a new pool should be created and designated as the Chisum (San Andres) Pool, Chaves County, New Mexico, for San Andres production, described as:

Sec. 13, All;

to include Keller and Peterson State "A" Well No. 1, and other developments.

(6) That a new pool should be created and designated as the Tulk (Wolfcamp) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, for Wolfcamp production, described as:

(7) That a new pool should be created and designated as the Millman Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, for (Grayburg) production, described as:

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, upon its own motion, for the creation of new pools or the extension of existing pools in Lea, Eddy and Chaves Counties, New Mexico, is hereby approved, and,

(a) That a new pool be, and the same hereby is, created for Devonian production designated as the East Caprock (Devonian) pool, Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool, and described as:

(b) That the boundaries of the Saunders Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore defined and described, be and the same hereby are extended to include:

Sec. 2, W/2;
Sec. 4, E/2;

(c) That the boundaries of the Artesia Pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore defined and described be, and the same hereby are extended to include:

(d) That a new pool be, and the same hereby is created for San Andres production, designated as the Chisum-San Andres Pool, Chavez County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool, and described as:

(e) That a new pool be, and the same hereby is created for Wolfcamp production, designated as the Tulk (Wolfcamp) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool, and described as:

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(f) That a new pool be, and the same hereby is created for Grayburg production, designated as the Millman (Grayburg) pool, Eddy County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool, and described as:

(g) That a new pool be, and the same hereby is created for Devonian production, designated as the Echol (Devonian) Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, classified as an oil pool, and described as:

Sec. 33, SW/4;

Twp. 11S., Rge. 37E., N.M.P.M.
Sec. 2, All;
