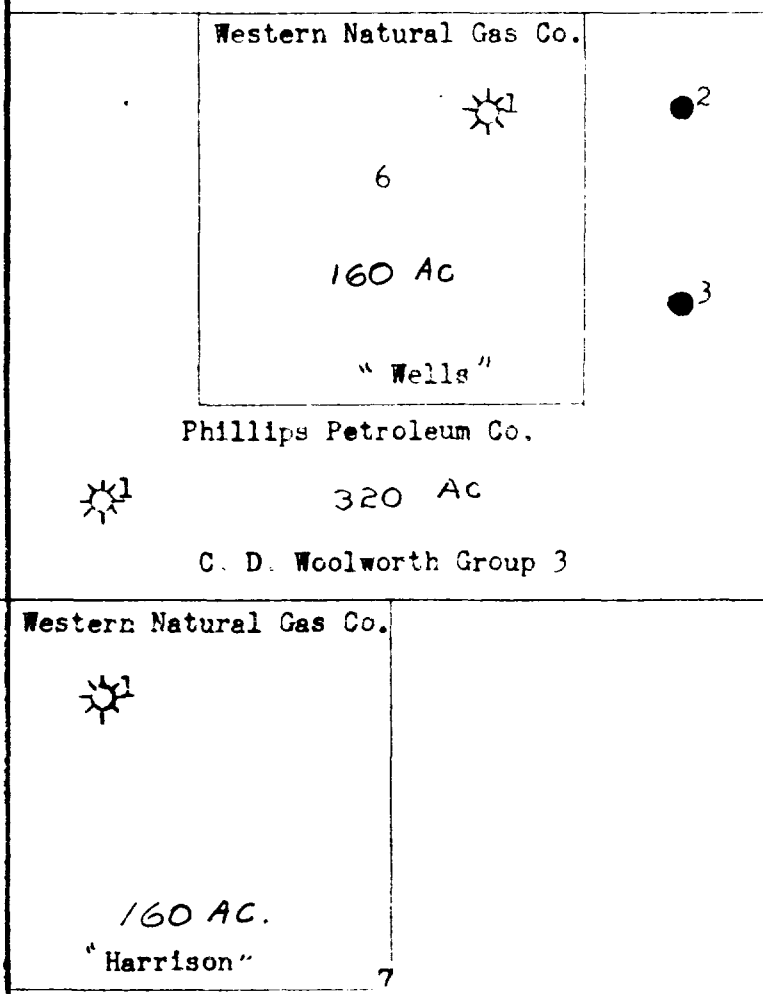

THE APPLICATION OF PHILLIPS PETROLEUM  
COMPANY FOR AN ORDER ESTABLISHING AN  
UNORTHODOX GAS UNIT FOR ITS C. D. WOOLWORTH  
GROUP 3 WELL NO. 1, SW/4 SW/4 OF SECTION 6,  
TOWNSHIP 25S., RANGE 37 E., NMPM, COOPER-JAL  
POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, AND SEEKING AN  
EXCEPTION TO COMMISSION RULE 104 (d) AND ESTABLISH-  
ING AN UNORTHODOX PRODUCING UNIT.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 10 a. m. November 20, 1951,  
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New  
Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission," all members being  
present.

NOW, this 8<sup>th</sup> day of January, 1952, the Commission, a quorum being  
present, having considered the testimony adduced and exhibits received at  
said hearing, and upon proper notice, having considered the records of  
the Commission, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS: (1) That due public notice having been given as required by  
law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter  
thereof.

(2) That the Phillips Petroleum Company C. D. Woolworth  
Group 3 Well No. 1, SW/4 SW/4 Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37  
East, NMPM, in the Cooper-Jal Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, was  
originally completed as an oil well in the Seven Rivers formation, with a  
high gas-oil ratio.

(3) That said well has not appeared on the Commission's  
proration schedule since March, 1947, and has not shown oil production since  
December, 1946, but instead has been produced as a gas well from the Upper  
Seven Rivers formation.

(4) That the well does not lie within the boundaries of any  
defined gas pool.

(5) That request for the allotment of a proration unit to  
said well was withdrawn at said hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the Phillips Petroleum Company C. D. Woolworth Group 3  
Well No. 1 SW/4 SW/4 Section 6, Township 25 South, Range 37 East, NMPM,

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CASE NO. 326  
ORDER NO. R-125

in the Cooper-Jal Pool, Lea County, New Mexico, be, and the same hereby is classified as a gas well, and entitled to produce gas for sale or distribution subject to state law and the rules and regulations of this Commission promulgated thereunder.
