ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This matter came on for hearing at 10 a. m. on the 18th day of December 1951, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on the day of March 1952, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits introduced in evidence and arguments presented, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due notice having been given according to law, and all interested parties having appeared, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause, and the subject matter hereof.
- (2) That the evidence adduced fails to show that production within the pool, at this time, has approached demand necessitating the establishment of proration of production.
- (3) That this case should be continued for such a time as may be required for operators in the pool to ascertain the deliverability of production from wells, and for the preparation of information (such as decline curves, etc.) upon which proration of production within the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool could be set up and established as a basis of experience.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

- (1) That extension of the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool boundary will be considered in Case 331, pending before the Commission.
- (2) That application for proration in the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool is pending presentation of further evidence.

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That this case be and it hereby is continued and that a further hearing be held at the regularly advertised December 1952 hearing of the Commission, at which time evidence will be heard with reference to interim production experience in said pool.
