Memo to Commission

Case 391 - The Application of Stanolind Oil & Gas Company for continuation of Order R-195 for a one-year period commencing October 1. (This Order deals with 80-acre spacing in the Fowler Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.

Recommendation:

It is recommended that an Order be entered (Order No. R-195-A) continuing the 80-acre spacing program in the Fowler Pool. ✓

It is requested that the operators in the Pool continue to supply this commission with the items as requested in paragraphs 7 & 8 of Order R-195. It is also requested that some terminology should be introduced into the Order requesting the operators to attempt to unitize the entire pool so that there will be no inequities due to the 80-acre spacing program.

This Pool was originally drilled on an 80-acre pattern by federal government permission and it was necessary for the operators to come to the Commission a year ago because the pool limits extended outside the federal acreage area. There is some state and some patented land which is productive. ✓
