DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. WHITE:

- Q State your name and occupation for the record, please.
- A R. S. Blymm, Engineering, Oil Conservation Commission.
- Q In your capacity as engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission have you had occasion to make a study of the proposed extensions as advertised in Case No. 415?
 - A Yes.
 - Q Give a report of your studies together with the recommend-

ations and conclusions?

A Case No. 415 consists of Sections A and B. Section A dealing with the proposed extension to West Dollarhide-Drinkard Pool, Section B concerned with the proposed extension to Teas Pool. I have prepared plats of both sections, showing the pool as presently constituted and the proposed extension, and recommend that both extensions be made as advertised and as shown on these plats.

Q What is your reason for the extensions?

A To include wells producing from this source of supply in these designated pools.

Q The same common source of supply then?

A Yes.

Q Will you mark those as Exhibits 1 and 2 specifically, and they will be offered into evidence?
