TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

(Notice of publication read by Mr. Graham.)

ELVIS A. UTZ,

having been previously duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. WHITE:

Q Will you state your name and position?

A Elvis A. Utz, Engineer, Oil Conservation Commission.

Q You are the same Mr. Utz that formerly testified this

morning as engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission?

A I am.

Q In your capacity as engineer, have you made a study of the proposed extensions as were advertised in Case 421?

A Yes, and I recommend that these pools be entended as advertised.

Q What is your reason for the recommendation?

A These extensions have been brought about by completion of producing wells or wells capable of producing in the same producing formations.

Q In your opinion, it is all within the same common source of supply, a, b, c respectively?

A That is right.

Q In existing pools?

A Yes.

MR. WHITE: That is all.

MR. SPURRIER: Any questions of this witness? Are there any objections to the proposed extensions or creations? If not, the witness may be excused. The meeting^{is}/adjourned.


