In the Matter of:

The application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon its own motion for an order for the extension of existing pools in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, and giving notice to all persons and parties interested in the subject matter thereof to appear and show cause why such extensions should not be made.

(a) Extend the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 27 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, SE/4 Section 19; all Section 20; all Section 29; E/2 Section 30; Township 27 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, SW/4 Section 36; Township 26 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, All Section 1, N/2 Section 12 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.

(b) Extend the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool to include: Township 29 North, Range 6 West, NMPM, All Sections 5 thru 8, incl., all Sections 17 and 18; Township 29 North, Range 8 West, NMPM, All Sections 1 through 5, incl., All Sections 8 through 17, incl.; Township 32 North, Range 11 West, NMPM, All Sections 13, 14, 23 and 26 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.

(c) Extend the Dogie Canyon-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 26 North, Range 7 West, NMPM, All Section 15, N/2 Section 22 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.

(d) Extend the West Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 26 North, Range 10 West, NMPM, W/2 Section 4, All Section 8 and such other lands contiguous to said pool as may properly be included therein as supported by proper testimony and recommendations adduced at said hearing.
