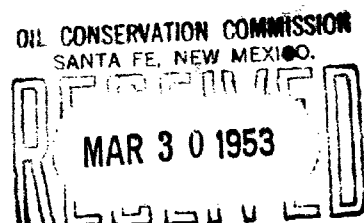

(Notice of Publication read by Mr. Graham.)

ELVIS A. UTZ

having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. WHITE:

Q Will you state your name for the Commission?

A Elvis A. Utz, Engineer, Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Have you, in your capacity as engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission, had occasion to make a study of the proposed extension of pools?

A As advertised in Case 525, yes, I have.

Q Will you give the Commission a report of your studies and conclusions and recommendations?

A I recommend that the pools be extended as advertised and submit an exhibit stating those extensions and my reasons for making those extensions. The basis, of course, is on the completion of producing wells.

MR. WHITE: We ask that the exhibit be admitted in evidence.

MR. SPURRIER: Without objection it will be received. Are there any questions of the witness? If not the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. SPURRIER: Are there any objections to these proposed changes? If not the case will be taken under advisement and the meeting is adjourned.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 17, 1953, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 10th day of April, 1953, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That the Pettigrew-Tocito Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include:
