

CASE 534: PROPOSED REVISION OF RULE 402 AND ADOPTION
OF FORM C-125 AND RULE 1124 PERTAINING TO THE
FILING OF RESULTS OF SHUT-IN-PRESSURE TESTS
ON GAS WELLS.

RULE 402:

(a) Shut-in-Pressures shall be taken by the operator on all gas wells during the months of April and October of each year, unless the taking of such pressures is covered by a special pool order.

(b) Shut-In-Pressures shall be taken with dead weight gauge after a minimum shut-in period of twenty-four hours, such shut-in period shall be reported to the Commission. All shut-in pressures shall be reported to the Commission on Form C-125.

RULE 1124: GAS WELL SHUT IN PRESSURE TESTS

Form C-125 shall be submitted in triplicate to the Oil Conservation Commission, Santa Fe, New Mexico, and shall be used to report Shut In Pressure tests on gas wells as required under the Provisions of Rule 402.
