Comes the undersigned, Atlantic Pipe Line Company, a corporation with offices at Dallas, Texas, and hereby makes application for a permit, if such a permit be required, to operate a temporary portable treating plant on its Leach Tank Farm at Hobbs, New Maxico, for the treating of approximately 25,000 barrels of basic sediment and water which has accumulated in the tanks on its Leach Tank Farm and in connection therewith respectfully shows:

- 1. That the proposed operation is merely a temporary one for the purpose of treating and processing only approximately 25,000 barrels of basic sediment and water which has accumulated in its own tanks on its Leach Tank Farm over a period of several years; after the treating and processing of which, no further operation of the temporary plant is contemplated at this time;
- 2. That the applicant operates an oil pipe line as a common carrier and that the above mentioned basic sediment and water was accumulated in tankage on its leach Tank Farm from oil transported through that portion of applicant's pipe line facilities in the course of its pipe line operations;
- 3. That the above mentioned treating plant will actually and efficiently process, treat and reclaim whatever tank bottom emulsion and other waste oils as may be contained in the basic sediment and water to be processed.
