figures, and be able to present testimony as a result of that com-
pilation.

MR. MACY: We have received, Mr. Spurrier, the information,
cost information on 140 wells, total wells, and some of this in-
formation was received in the last two or three days. It is our
thought that the companies, in order to expedite the matter, should
have this information presented to them before the next hearing so
they could go over it, and we can settle the matter at the hearing
next month. Therefore, I would like to concur in Mr. Madule's
request for continuance.
