### COMPLETION DATA


PACIFIC WESTERN'S State "D" #1 well was completed in December, 1936, in open hole below 5½" OD casing set at 3684' in the Grayburg formation. The well was drilled to a total depth of 3860' and potentialed 20 BOPD.

In May, 1951, the well was perforated between the intervals,  $3410 - 3440^{\circ}$ ,  $3470 - 3490^{\circ}$ ,  $3520 - 3523^{\circ}$ ,  $3540 - 3570^{\circ}$ , all in the vertical limits of the Eumont Gas Pool in the Queen formation. The oil and gas zones are segregated by a Baker production packer set at a depth of  $3620^{\circ}$  in the  $5\frac{1}{2}$ " casing.

### Gentlemen:
