Q Will you supply the information for the benefit of the Commission?

A I will.

MR. SPURRIER: Is there any objection? If not proceed.

A In Case 651 (b) creation of the Skaggs-Drinkard 0il Pool discovered by the Texas Company, C. H. Weir B No. 1, in Section 11, Township 20 South, Range 37 East, the top of the perforation is 6,856. In support of my testimony I wish to introduce these plats.

MR. SPURRIER: Without objection they will be admitted. Does anyone have a question of the witness? The witness may be excused. We will take the case under advisement and move on to Case 652.
