We have studied your problem as set forth in your letter of December 11 regarding your attempts to form a unit for your Bordages No. 1 Well, NW/4 WW/4 Section 33, Township 19 South, Range 37 East, Lea County (in the Eumont Gas Pool).

It will be necessary for you to apply for hearing before the Gommission as far as approval of the unorthedox gas promation unit is concerned. Your application (asking for exception to Rule 7(a) of Order No. R-370-A) should be submitted in triplicate to this office, and the case will thereupon be advertised for the regular hearing on February 17, 1954.

With regard to the other aspect of the situation, however - the unorthodox location of the well - it is possible for you to comply with requirements as set forth in Rule 4 of Order R-370-A, and if no objections are received from offset operators, approval may be granted without hearing. Dear Sir:

On September 12, 1952 we requested permission on Form 9-311 A to test a gas zone (Queens) in our Bordages #1 Well, located in the NW/4 of the NW/4 Section 33, Township 19S, Range 37E, Lea County, New Mexico (Eumont Field).

This was an old well depleted as an oil producer in the Grayburg formation.

The above lease is a Federal lease, surrounded by Fee land. We were requested by the Federal Land Commissioner and the U. S. G. S. that a gas well was due this lease as an offset to the Southern Union Gas Company well in the NE/4 of Section 33, Township 19S, Range 37E. We obtained permission to re-complete the Bordages #1 as an off-set to the above stated well. Formal application and acceptance was made, the work completed and a back pressure test sent you on the Bordages #1 December 3, 1952.

Since that time this well has been flowing into the Southern Union Gas Company lines under a pressure of 800#. The average monthly sales range from 24 to 25 MMCF.

Under the Commission orders adopted by the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico and that will go into effect January 1, 1954, we are enclosing a map showing the Federal unit (which does not conform to Rule 7-A in that one 40 acre parcellies within Section 28; the other three 40 acre tracts all being contiguous in Section 33.)

We tried unsuccessfully to unitize the 40 acres in Section 28 on a trade-out with Gulf so that it would be possible to include their 40 acres, which is the SW/4 of the NW/4 of Section

33, Township 19S, Range 37E. However, due to the fact that this particular 40 acres was Fee Land and had a producing oil well within its boundary made unitization a very impractical solution at the time.

I made a trip to Santa Fe in January, 1953 and talked to you personally about the situation and it was my understanding that since it was a Federal lease that we had met the requirements of the U. S. G. S. and that the State Proration Commission would accept the 160 acre Federal Government lease as a proration unit.

Under the new rules, we would seem to have two inconsistencies: (1) the 160 acres do not lie within a legal quarter section; (2) and that this old well was drilled 330° from the lease line. However, the off-set to this well is in the quarter section to the east.

Would you please advise me as to what steps we should take to be able to obtain a full 160 acre proration unit.
