

BEFORE THE OIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION STATE OF NEW MEXICO at Santa Fe, New Mexico February 18, 1954 Afternoon Session In the Matter of: Application of the Oil Conservation Commission Case No. 669 upon its own motion for an order exempting the South Leonard Pool from the requirements of Rule 506 (paragraph 'd') pertaining to Gas-Oil Ratio Limitations, and from the requirements of Rule 301. pertaining to the filing of Form C-116. Gas-Oil Ratio Test. (Notice of Publication read.) WILLIAM B. MACEY testified as follows: DIRECT EXAMINATION By MR. YOST: State your name, please. A William B. Macey. Q What is your position. Mr. Macey?. Q I am Chief Engineer for the Oil Conservation Commission. Α You have testifed before the Commission before, have you not? Q Yes, sir. A Are his qualifications acceptable? MR. YOST: MR. SPURRIER: They are. Q Case 669 involves application of the Oil Conservation Commission upon it's own motion, for the order from the requirements of rule 506 (paragraph 'd') pertaining to Gas-Oil Ratio Limitations and from the requirements of rule 301 pertaining to the filing of

Q Will you please give the commission the benefit of your observations in the matter and any recommendation that you might care to make?

A South Leonard Pool is located in Township 26 South, Range 37 East. Sections 23 and 24. It is in an area which is south of the Langlie Mattix Oil Pool and east of the Rhodes Pool. It is also in the immediate area of the Leonard Oil Pool. The Commission has previously removed the Gas-Oil Ratio limit from these three The south Leonard Pool has 14 producing wells which have an pools. average productivity of five barrels per day. The gas production averages 60,000 cubic feet per well per day. All of the casinghead gas is, to the best of our knowledge, being sold to gasoline plants operating in the area. Since the field is obviously a marginal field and the income from the property is very limited, it is requested that this Commission enter an order removing the Gas-Oil Ratio limit and also exempting the field from the requirements of filing annual Gas-Oil Ratio tests.

MR. SPURRIER: Are there any questions of the witness? If not, the witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)

MR. SPURRIER: Does anyone have anything further in this case? We will take the case under advisement and move on to Case 670.
