In our preparation for drilling a test on this prospect, we realised the presence of multiple shallow seismic reflections which may mask a deep-coated structure, and experimental seismic surveys conducted in September of this year confirmed the presence of these reflections and additional investigation and study is warranted. The presence of three dry Silure-Devonian tests on the northwest flank of the sec-wall Samyer Devonian field in Section 2, T-9-5, in-30-4, has prompted us to take a closer look at our data. This field is located on an enomaly of similar magnitude to the one in the southeast part of the fluit Unit.

this anomaly in the southeast part of the unit. In this connection, there is such a short time before the unit empires and coupled with the temporary shortage or evaluable deep rigs, it is deubtful if drilling could be commenced before the expiration of the unit. We are also considering the possibility of additional drilling to evaluate the units of the Muit feature near the Bluit Unit No. 1 test either by oun-account drilling or through test-promotion.

#### Gentlemen:

Under the terms of Section 9 of the Bluit Unit Agreement, we request that a six month extension of time he granted to Shell Oil Company, as Unit Operator of the Bluit Unit, within which to commence the drilling of the third test well within the Unit area. Under the terms of the Bluit Unit Agreement, the third test should be commenced on or before July 4, 1956, unless an extension is granted.

The shell-bluit Unit No. 1, located in Section 11, Township 8 wouth, names 37 mast, was spudded on April 8, 1954, and was completed dry and acamoned on September 23, 1954. This well reached a total depth of 9700 feet in pre-tamorian granite. Brill stem tests were made in the San Andres delouite, the Abo-wolfcamp dolomite, and the Pennsylvanian limestone. No significant shows of hydrocarbon were encountered except in the San Andres section.

After reaching a total aepth of 9700 feet, bluit buit too. I was plubted back to dot0 feet in the san Amires dolomite and was subjected to fracture treatment. Although a small quantity of gas was obtained as a result of this artificial stimulation, the accumulation was too small to constitute a consercial well, and the test was abandoned.

theil, bluit buit No. 2, in the Na-1/4 section 11, 1-d-s, 1-j7-b, was spudded August 15, 1955. This test was drilled on a seismic anomaly in the countern part of the unit and reached a total depth of 12,597 feet in the pre-Jambrian basement rocks. Bluit No. 2 encountered no significant shows of oil and has an ass acandoned on Jamusry 5, 1956.
