

Gentlemen:

The Unit Agreement for the development and operation of the Bluit Unit Area in Townships 7 and 8 South, Ranges 37 and 38 East, NMPM, Roosevelt County, New Mexico, was approved by the Acting Director, Mr. Thomas B. Nolan, on April 15, 1954, for a term of five years unless extended or terminated.

Since forming the Bluit Unit, we have drilled two Devonian tests and promoted a third and also drilled two shallower San Andres tests. All of these tests failed to encounter hydrocarbons in paying quantities and all five wells have been plugged and abandoned.

Section 20 of the Unit Agreement provides for termination at any time by not less than seventy-five per centum, on an acreage basis, of the owners of working interests signatory thereto, with the approval of the Director.

The undersigned, representing more than the required per centum of working interest ownership, hereby elect to terminate the said Unit Agreement effective as of the first day of the calendar month immediately following your approval of such termination and respectfully request approval thereof by you.

Gentlemen:

Under the terms of Section 9 of the Bluit Unit Agreement, we request that a six month extension of time be granted to Shell Oil Company, as Unit Operator of the Bluit Unit, within which to commence the drilling of the second test well within the Unit area. Under the terms of the Bluit Unit Agreement, the second test should be commenced on or before March 23, 1955, unless an extension is granted.

The Shell-Bluit Unit No. 1, located in Section 14, Township 8 South, Range 37 East, was spudded on April 8, 1954, and was completed dry and abandoned on September 23, 1954. This well reached a total depth of 9700 feet in pre-Cambrian granite. Drill stem tests were made in the San Andres dolomite, the Abo-Wolfcamp dolomite, and the Pennsylvanian limestone. No significant shows of hydrocarbon were encountered except in the San Andres section.

After reaching a total depth of 9700 feet, Bluit Unit Mo. 1 was plugged back to 4600 feet in the San Andres dolomite and was subjected to fracture treatment. Although a small quantity of gas was obtained as a result of this artificial stimulation, the accumulation was too small to constitute a commercial well, and the test was abandoned.

Data from our unit test and from other deep wildcats nearby indicate that prospects for an oil accumulation at Bluit are still favorable because of the updip wedging of early Paleosoic objectives which must occur in this general area.

Since the completion of Shell, Bluit Unit No. 1, we have shot 38 miles of new seismic profile here. We are currently revising our structural

interpretations on the basis of data obtained from this recent shooting. We have encountered difficulties in interpreting the structural complexities of the area, and cannot be certain of completing our studies before the expiry date of the unit.

We, therefore, formally request that a six month extension of time in which to commence a second test be greated the operator of captioned unit, said extension to run from March 23, 1955, until September 23, 1955.
