

We have your request of April 1, 1954, on behalf of Claud E. Aikman for a hearing for approval of a projected unorthodox gas proration unit consisting of S/2 NE/4 and N/2 SE/4 of Section 7, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
