Northwestern New Mexico nomenclature case, for creation of new pools and extension of existing pools, as follows: (a) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the North Los Pinos - Fruitland Pool for Fruitland production, and described as: Township 32 North, Range 7 West, Partial Sections 7 and 8, all of Sections 17 and 18 (b) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the Aztec-Fruitland Pool for Fruitland Production, and described as: Township 29 North, Range 11 West, All Sections 11, 13, 14, 23 and 24 (c) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the South Los Pinos - Fruitland Pool for Fruitland Production and described as: Township 31 North, Range 7 West, All Sections 8, 9, 16 and 17 (d) Creation of a new gas pool in Rio Arriba County, designated as the Cottonwood-Fruitland Pool for Fruitland production, and described as: Township 31 North, Range 5 West Partial Sections 2 and 3 Township 32 North, Range 5 West All Sections 34 and 35 (e) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the West Kutz-Fruitland Pool for Fruitland production, and described as: Township 29 North, Range 13 West, All Sections 13, 14, 23 and 24 (f) Creation of a new gas pool in Rio Arriba County, designated as the La Jara Fruitland Pool for Fruitland production, and described as: Township 30 North, Range 5 West Sections 7 and 18, all Township 30 North, Range 6 West, All of Sections 12 and 13 (g) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the Twin Mounds - Mesaverde Pool for Mesaverde production, and described as: Township 29 North, Range 14 West, All Sections 4, 5, 8 and 9 (h) Creation of a new gas pool in San Juan County, designated as the Hogback Pennsylvanian Pool for production from the Pennsylvanian, and described as: Township 29 North, Range 16 West SW/4 Section 17; S/2 Section 18; all Section 19; W/2 Section 20 (i) Extension of the East Blanco Pictured Cliffs Pool to include: Township 30 North, Range 4 West All Sections 28, 29 and 30.
