TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. SPURRIER: Case Number 725.

M. J. EDWARDSON

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. HUGHSTON:

Q You are prepared to state that the facts stated there are true and correct?

A Yes, sir.

(Marked Shell's Exhibit No. 1, for identification.)

MR. HUGHSTON: We offer the plat in evidence as Shell's

Exhibit 1.

- MR. SPURRIER: Without objection it will be admitted.
- Q This is the same area or the unit will involve the same area as that involved in Case 723, will it not, Mr. Edwardson?
 - A Yes, sir.
- Q There, as in Case 723, you have three wells that are completed in the gas formation under consideration, which is the Blinebry, in the north half of the section?
 - A Yes, sir.
- Q And there, as in Case 723, Tidewater has been granted an unorthodox unit consisting of the north half of the northwest quarter and the north half of the northeast quarter?
 - A Yes. sir.
 - Q Will you give us the number of that order and case?
- A I can give you the order number. It is Order R-449. I don't have the case number.
- Q The well, as to which the unorthodox unit is requested, will you give us the date on which it was completed in the Blinebry?
- A Shell State 2 is a Blinebry-Drinkard dual well which was completed as a dual December 9, 1952.
- Q It has been on the proration allowable for the past months beginning January 1, 1954 and up to date?
 - A Yes, sir, in the Blinebry proration schedule.
- Q Shell was authorized to complete the well as a dual completion. Will you give us the number of that order?
 - A The permission to dually complete the well in the Blinebry

and Drinkard was granted in Order Number R-189, dated August 28, 1952, by the Oil Conservation Commission.

Q It would be impractical in view of the Tidewater unit to effect a unitization of the northeast quarter of Section 15, would it not?

A That is right.

MR. HUGHSTON: That is all.

MR. SPURRIER: Does anyone have a question of the witness in Case 725? If not we will take this one under advisement and move on th Case 724.

(Witness excused.)
