THE AMENDED APPLICATION OF EL PASO
NATURAL GAS COMPANY FOR AN ORDER GRANTING
APPROVAL OF AN EXCEPTION PURSUANT TO RULE
7(A) OF ORDER NO. R-370-A IN ESTABLISHMENT
OF AN UNORTHODOX GAS PRORATION UNIT OF
234.81 CONTIGUOUS ACRES CONSISTING OF LOTS
3, 4, 5, 6, 11 and 12 IN SECTION 2, TOWNSHIP
21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM, LEA COUNTY,
NEW MEXICO, IN THE EUNONT GAS POOL.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on July 15, 1954,
at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico,
hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this th12 day of August, 1954, the Commission, a quorum
being present, having considered the testimony adduced and the records in
the case, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose
thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction
of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That pursuant to provisions of Rule 7(a) of Order No. R-370-A,
the Commission has power and authority to permit the formation of a gas pro-
ration unit consisting of other than a legal quarter section after notice
and hearing by the Commission.

(3) (a) That applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, is the owner
of an oil and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico, the land consisting of
other than a legal quarter section, and described as follows, to-wit:

Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
Lots 5, 6, 11 and 12 of
Section 2

containing 160 acres, more or less.

(b) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation is the owner of an oil
and gas lease in Lea County, New Mexico, the land consisting of other than
a legal quarter section, and described as follows, to-wit:

Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
Lots 3 and 4 of Section 2

containing 74.81 acres, more or less.

(4) That applicant, El Paso Natural Gas Company, has a well on the
aforesaid lease known as the Shell-State No. 5, located 3209 feet from the
north line and 660 feet from the west line of Section 2, Township 21 South,
Range 36 East.

(5) That the aforesaid well is located within the limits of the pool heretofore delineated and designated as the Eumont Gas Pool.

(6) (a) That it is impractical to pool applicant's said lease with adjoining acreage in the north half of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, and that owners of adjoining acreage in said half sections have not objected to the formation of the proposed proration unit of 234.81 acres, but have expressly consented thereto.

(b) That Amerada Petroleum Corporation has consented to the formation of the proposed proration unit.

(7) That unless a proration unit consisting of applicant's aforesaid acreage is permitted, applicant will be deprived of the opportunity to recover its just and equitable share of the natural gas in the Eumont Gas Pool.

(8) That creation of a proration unit consisting of the aforesaid acreage will not cause but will prevent waste and will protect correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the amended application of El Paso Natural Gas Company for approval of an unorthodox proration unit consisting of the following described acreage:

Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM
Lots 3, 4, 5, 6, 11 and 12 of
Section 2

be, and the same hereby is approved, and a proration unit consisting of aforesaid acreage is hereby created.

(2) That applicant's well, Shell-State No. 5, located in Lot 12 of Section 2, Township 21 South, Range 36 East, NMPM, shall be granted an allowable in the proportion that the above described 234.81-acre unit bears to the standard or orthodox proration unit for said pool, all until further order of the Commission.
