Dear Sir:

In conjunction with the hearing of the Phillips #1,
I would appreciate very much if at the same time we could
have hearing on locations 2 and 3, located in Sections 10
and 11, Township 28 N, Range 13 W in San Juan County, New
Mexico.

These locations were staked by Ernest V. Echohawk,
Registered Land Surveyor, on the only accessible terrain
that would lie within the units desired, being location # 2,
1630 feet from the East line and 840 feet from the North
line of Section 11 T-28N, R-13W. To this location it is
desirous to allocate lots 1, 2, 3, and 4 in Section 11, and
1 and 2 in Section 10, consisting of 173 acres more or less.
The accompanying plats show the location and the offset
operators.

Phillips # 3 being located 1140 feet from the South
line and 490 feet from the East line of Section 10 T-28 N,
R-13 W. It is desirous to allocate the South half of Section
10 consisting of 160 acres more or less to this location.
The accompanying plat shows all offset operators.

If any additional information is required or if this
form is not in proper order, please advise along with instruc-
tions of how the filing should be made.
