TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SW/4 of Section 31

#### CRDER OF THE COMMISSION

### BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m., on June 23, 1955, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this  $32^{t/2}$  day of July, 1955, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the records and testimony adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

### FINDS:

(1) That due notice of the time and place of hearing and the purpose thereof having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That extensions of the Arrow Gas Pool, Corbin Pool, Dollarhide-Queen Fool, Eumont Gas Fool, Jalmat Gas Pool, Langlie-Mattix Pool, and Townsend-Wolfcamp Fool, all in Lea County, New Mexico, and the Grayburg-Jackson Fool in Eddy County, New Mexico, should be approved as advertised and as modified by testimony and recommendations set forth at the subject hearing.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

That the application of the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission be, and it hereby is approved, as follows:

(a) That the Arrow Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHLP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 36 EAST, NMPM SW/4 of Section 24

TOWNSHIP 21 SOUTH, RANGE 37 EAST, NMPM SE/4 of Section 31 -2-Order No. R-667

(b) That the Corbin Bool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM 5E/4 of Section 34

> TOWNSHIP 18 SCUTH, RANGE 33 EAST, NMPM NE/4 of Section 16

(c) That the Dollarhide-Queen Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

(a) That the Eumont Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:

(e) That the Jalmat Gas Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

(f) That the Langlie-Mattix Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

> TOWNSHIP 25 SOUTH, RANGE 38 FAST, NMPM W/2 of Section 18 W/2 of Section 19

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(g) That the Townsend-Wolfcamp Pool in Lea County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, should be extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 16 SOUTH, RANGE 35 EAST, NMPM SE/4 of Section 2 NE/4 of Section 11

(h) That the Grayburg-Jackson Pool in Eddy County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described should be extended to include therein:
