Reference is made to your application of June 3, 1955, pertaining to the enlargement of Area B and the creation of a new Area A in the so called oil - potash area of Eddy and Lea Counties. This case will be assigned a case number in the near future and will be set for hearing on July 14th.

I would like to call your attention to the fact that three cases are pending before the Commission pertaining to the enlargement of Area A. These cases are 889, 890 and 891. At the May hearing on these cases it was deemed advisable to set up a committee to be composed of two representatives of the oil industry, two representatives of the potash industry and myself to resolve the situation and to determine the best course of action to be followed in handling the entire question of joint operation in the potash - oil area. We are planning on having a meeting of this committee in the near future, and in the event you or any representative of your company desires to observe the proceedings, we would be more than happy to have you present. At the first meeting of this committee I will acquaint them of the facts concerning your application.




