Gentlemen:

Sinclair Oil & Gas Company makes this application for an order establishing uniform spacing of wells in the area of Sinclair's Well #1 J. P. Dean lease and certain land adjacent thereto in Lea County, New Mexico. In this connection Sinclair represents to the Commission:

(1) Sinclair Oil & Gas Company is the operator of an oil well recently completed in the Devonian formation located in the center of the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and that said well was completed through casing perforations from 13,600 feet to 13,725 feet.

(2) It appears that the Devonian formation will probably be productive of oil under the following described land:

Township 15 South, Range 36 East
All of Section 26
All of Section 35
East 1/2 of NE/4 of Section 34
SE/4 of Section 34

Township 16 South, Range 37 East
Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Section 5
Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 6

The aforesaid area being outlined in red on a plat attached to this application.

(3) It is requested that an order be entered establishing a

uniform spacing of wells in the aforesaid area completed in the Devonian formation and that said wells be required to be drilled in the center of 40 acre tracts which are substantially in the form of a square that is a legal subdivision of the United States Land Surveys or on a governmental quarter quarter section or lot, with a tolerance allowance of 150 feet in any direction from the center of said 40 acre tract when such tolerance is necessary in order to avoid structures or natural obstructions.


(4) Such spacing of wells as herein requested will insure orderly development of said area, protect correlative rights and prevent possible waste providing same is developed on a 40 acre spacing pattern with the wells to be drilled in the center of said tracts with the allowance of the tolerance of 150 feet hereinabove referred to.

(1) Sinclair Oil & Gas Company is the operator of an oil well recently completed in the Devonian formation located in the center of the SE/4 of the SW/4 of Section 35, Township 15 South, Range 36 East, Lea County, New Mexico, and that said well was completed through casing perforations from 13,600 feet to 13,725 feet.

(2) It appears that the Devonian formation will probably be productive of oil under the following described land:

Township 15 South, Range 36 East

All of Section 26

All of Section 35

East 1/2 of NE/4 of Section 34

SE/4 of Section 34

Township 16 South, Range 37 East

Lots 1, 2, 3, 4, 5, 6, 7 and 8 of Section 5

Lots 1, 2, 7 and 8 of Section 6

The afore said area being outlined in red on a plat attached to this application.

(3) It is requested that an order be entered establishing a uniform spacing of wells in the aforesaid area completed in the Devonian formation and that said wells be required to be drilled in the center of 40 acre tracts which are substantially in the form of a square that is a legal subdivision of the United States Land Surveys or on a governmental quarter quarter section or lot, with a tolerance allowance of 150 feet in any direction from the center of said 40 acre tract when such tolerance is necessary in order to avoid structures or natural obstructions.
