TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

HEARING EXAMINER MANKIN: The Hearing will come to order. The first case on the docket is Case 1003, which is the application of Lowry for an exception to the rules of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Gas Pool as set out in Order R-565-C. Do we have appearances in that particular case today?

MR. KELLAHIN: Jason Kellahin, Santa Fe, New Mexico, appearing for Lowry, et al, Operating Account, the applicant. At this time, if the Examiner please, we would like to ask for indefinite postponement of the case in this matter on the grounds that we are now in the process of attempting to communitize the omitted acreage for the formation of a standard unit. We would like the indefinite postponement rather than dismissal because it may become necessary to file an amended application.

MR. MANKIN: Is there objection to the indefinite postponement of this Case 1003 at this time?

MR. KELLAHIN: I might add that both El Paso Natural Gas Company and the United States Geological Survey who were interested in this matter were advised of this request this morning.

MR. MANKIN: As no objection has been voiced to the indefinite postponement of this case, it will be so indefinitely postponed.
