1 OF THE SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS
OF THE SOUTH-KNOWLES DEVONIAN POOL,
LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, AS SET FORTH
IN ORDER NO. R-638-B AND THE DRILLING
OF WELLS THEREON; SAID UNITS TO CONSIST
OF THE N/2 SW/4 AND S/2 SW/4 OF SECTION
13, TOWNSHIP 17 SOUTH, RANGE 38 EAST.

ORDER OF DISMISSAL

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on
March 7, 1956, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before Warren W. Mankin,
Examiner duly appointed by the Oil Conservation Commission of New
Mexico, in accordance with Rule 1214 of Order No. R-681.

NOW, on this 29th day of March 1956, the Oil Con-
servation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the
"Commission", a quorum being present, having considered the motion
of dismissal and the recommendations thereon of the Examiner, Warren
W. Mankin, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That motion has been filed to dismiss, by applicant
in this case, therefore application should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

1. That application of Gulf Oil Corporation for an
order granting approval of two non-standard drilling and proration
units consisting of the N/2 SW/4 and S/2 SW/4 of Section 13, Town-
ship 17 South, Range 38 East, in exception to paragraph 1 of the
Special Rules and Regulations of the South Knowles Pool in Lea
County, New Mexico, as set forth in Order No. R-638-B and the drilling
of wells thereon, be and the same is hereby dismissed.
