TRANSCRIPT OF PROCEEDINGS

MR. PORTER: We will move on to Case No. 1056.

ELVIS A. UTZ,

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as  
follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION,

BY MR. GURLEY:

Q State your name and position, please.

A Elvis A. Utz, Engineer with the New Mexico Oil Conservation  
Commission.

Q Are you familiar, Mr. Utz, with the proposals involved in Case No. 1056?

A Yes, sir, I am.

Q Mr. Utz, in Case 1056, there are certain extensions recommended in Paragraphs (a) and (b). First, in Paragraph (a), proposed extension of the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool to include certain lands; do you have a recommendation on that, sir?

A Yes, sir. I recommend that the Ballard-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of two wells capable of producing.

Q And, in Paragraph (b), involving the extension of the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool, what is your recommendations therein?

A That the Canyon Largo-Pictured Cliffs Pool be extended as advertised on the basis of three wells capable of producing.

Q Do you have anything further to offer in this case?

A I have an exhibit which states those extensions advertised and the wells on which they are based.

MR. PORTER: Do you wish to submit this exhibit as part of the evidence?

A Yes, sir.

MR. GURLEY: We move the Commission to accept Exhibit A, Case 1056, into evidence.

MR. PORTER: Without objection it will be received. Are there any questions of the witness? The witness may be excused.

(Witness excused.)


MR. PORTER: Is there anything further in this case?
