ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on May 16, 1956 at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission".

NOW, on this 8th day of June, 1956, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

(1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.

(2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Pictured Cliffs formation, said pool to bear the designation Choza Mesa Pictured Cliffs Pool. Said Choza Mesa Pictured Cliffs Pool was discovered by El Paso Natural Gas Company, San Juan Unit 29-4 No. 2, located in the NE/4 SW/4 Section 35, Township 29 North, Range 4 West, NMPM. It was completed October 30, 1953.

(3) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in Sandoval County, New Mexico, for the production of oil from the Sanastee formation, said pool to bear the designation Otero-Sanastee Oil Pool. Said Otero-Sanastee Oil Pool was discovered by Humble Oil and Refining Company, Jicarilla "B" No. 1, located in the NE/4 NE/4 Section 1, Township 22 North, Range 5 West, NMPM. It was completed May 14, 1955. The top of the perforations is at 5,820 feet.

(4) That there is need for certain extensions to the Ballard Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Fulcher Kutz-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool all in San Juan County, New Mexico, the Otero-Pictured Cliffs Pool, in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

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(5) That that portion of paragraph (c) of this case pertaining to the proposed extension of the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in:

should be dismissed.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Pictured Cliffs production be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Chozas Mesa-Pictured Cliffs Pool consisting of the following described area:
