

Gentlemen:

In our letter of April 26th regarding an application for an unorthodox location for Southern Union Gas Company's No. 3-D Jicarilla well which we propose to locate in the SW/4 of Section 32, T-26N, R-3W, Rio arriba County, New Mexico, I note that we inadvertently asked for this location to be in the NW/4 instead of the SW/4. Please correct our letter in order that it might show that we intend to drill this 3-D well in the SW/4 of Section 32.

Southern Union further requests that in the event you are unable to grantadministrative approval that an examiner hearing be set-up for our application.

If it is necessary to set-up an examiner hearing to cover the 3-D well, we would like to request that this same hearing also cover the 5-E well which we propose to locate in the NW/4 of Section 16, T-26N, R-4W.

We have received today a copy of Order No. R-794 issued in Case No. 977 and note that in the Order an exception to the normal field spacing (wells to be located in the NE and SW quarters of each section) was granted for Southern Union Gas Company's 1-D Jicarilla well located in the NW/4 Section 32, T-26N, R-3W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

In order to conform to the new official spacing pattern, the second well to be drilled in said Section 32 would have to be located either in the NE/4 or SW/4 of the Section. Southern Union Gas Company hereby requests administrative approval for a further exception to the spacing pattern established in Order No. R-794, in order to permit the drilling of its Jicarilla 3-D well in the NW/4 of the aforesaid Section 32, thereby making its two wells in the Section diagonal rather than direct offsets.

We have received today a copy of Order No. R-794 issued in Case No. 977 and note that in the Order an exception to the normal field spacing (wells to be located in the NE and SW quarters of each section) was granted for Southern Union Gas Company's 1-E Jicarilla well located in the SE/4 Section 16, T-26N, R-4W, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico.

In order to conform to the new official spacing pattern, the second well to be drilled in said Section 16 would have to be located either in the NE/4 or the SW/4 of the Section. Southern Union Gas Company hereby requests administrative approval for a further, exception to the spacing pattern established in Order No. R-794, in order to permit the drilling of its Jicarilla 5-E well in the NW/4 of the afore-said Section 16, thereby making its two wells in the Section diagonal rather than direct offsets.

The U.S.G.S. has already approved the NW/4 location, since it was submitted to them before the issuance of Order Nc. R-794. We have already cleared the location and let a contract for the well to be spudded on or about May 1st.
