TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. PORTER: The next case is Case 1148.

R. F. MONTGOMERY
called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as
follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

By MR. COOLEY:

Q Mr. Montgomery, would you state for the record your full
name and position?

A Randall Montgomery, Proration Manager for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Have you previously testified before the Commission in an expert capacity?

A Yes, sir, I have.

Q In your capacity as Proration Manager for the Southeastern District of New Mexico, have you had an opportunity to observe conditions in the Justis Gas Pool?

A Yes, sir, I have.

Q Do you have any recommendations with respect to that pool?

A Yes, sir, I recommend that the pool be extended as advertized, and I have a plat which I have marked as Exhibit Number 1, which shows the extensions as advertized.

Q Have you made a study of the Lovington Paddock Pool?

A I have, and I recommend that Section (b) of this case be extended as advertised, and I have an Exhibit Number 2 which portrays that extension.

Q Have you likewise made a study of the Young Pool?

A I have, and I likewise recommend that it be extended as advertized, and I submit Exhibit 3, which outlines that area.

MR. COOLEY: That is all.

MR. PORTER: Are there any further questions of the witness? Do you want to offer these exhibits in evidence in this case, Mr. Montgomery?

A Yes, sir, I do.

MR. PORTER: Without objection they will be admitted. We will take the case under advisement.
