Southeastern New Mexico nomenclature case calling
for the creation of new pools and the extension of
existing pools in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico.

- (a) Creation of a new oil pool for Devonian
production, designated as the East Cross-
roads-Devonian Pool, and described as:

Township 9 South, Range 37 East
Section 30: NW/4

- (b) Creation of a new oil pool for Pennsylvanian
production, designated as the Dickinson-
Pennsylvania Pool, and described as:

Township 10 South, Range 36 East
Section 33: SW/4

- (c) Creation of a new oil pool for Connell produc-
tion, designated as the Fowler-Connell Pool,
and described as:

Township 24 South, Range 37 East
Section 22: NE/4

- (d) Creation of a new oil pool for Pennsylvanian
production, designated as the Querecho Plains-
Pennsylvanian Pool, and described as:

Township 18 South, Range 32 East
Section 22: SW/4

- (e) Extension of the Anderson Pool to include:

Township 17 South, Range 29 East
Section 10: S/2, NE/4 and S/2 NW/4

(f) Extension of the Atoka Pool to include:

Township 18 South, Range 26 East
Section 12: E/2 SW/4

(g) Extension of the Cave Pool to include:

Township 17 South, Range 29 East
Section 5: N/2 SW/4

TRANSCRIPT OF HEARING

MR. PORTER: The next case to be considered will be Case
No. 1222.

(Witness sworn.)

JOHN W. RUNYAN

called as a witness, having been first duly sworn, testified as
follows:

DIRECT EXAMINATION

BY: MR. COOLEY:

Q State your name and occupation for the record, sir.

A John W. Runyan, geologist for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission.

Q Mr. Runyan, in your official capacity for the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission, have you had an opportunity to make a study of creation and extension of existing pools in Lea and Eddy Counties, New Mexico?

A Yes, I have.

Q What are your recommendations concerning Devonian production in Township 9 South, Range 37 East?

A I recommend that a new pool, new oil pool be created as advertised and to be named the East Crossroads-Devonian Pool, due to the completion of Lone Star Producing Company's Santa Fe No. 1 in Unit C of Section 30, Township 9 South, Range 37 East, completed on 12/26/56 in the Devonian with the top of the perforations being at 12,173 feet.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning creation of an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production in Township 10 South, Range 36 East?

A Yes, I do. I recommend that this pool be created as advertised, named the Dickinson-Pennsylvanian Pool, and this creation is due to the completion of Magnolia Petroleum Company's Dickinson Heirs No. 1 in Unit M of Section 33, Township 10 South,

Range 36 East, completed in the Pennsylvanian the 1/28/57, the top of perforation being 11,504 feet.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the creation of a new oil pool for Connell production in Township 24 South, Range 37 East?

A Yes, I have. I recommend a new pool be created called the Fowler-Connell Pool. This creation is desired because of the completion of Pan American Petroleum Corporation's South Mattix Unit No. 3 in Unit B of Section 22, Township 24 South, Range 37 East, completed 1/20/57 in the Connell Formation, top of perforation being 9,711 feet.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the creation of an oil pool for Pennsylvanian production in Township 18 South, Range 32 East?

A Yes, sir. I recommend that a new pool be created called the Querecho Plains-Pennsylvanian Pool, and the purpose of this creation is the completion of Shell Oil Company's Querecho Plains Unit 1 in Unit K of Section 22, Township 18 South, Range 32 East, completed 1/11/57 in the Pennsylvanian, the top of perforation being 11,595 feet.

Q And the horizontal limits of that pool would be as advertised?

A That is correct.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning extension

of the Anderson Pool?

A I recommend that it be extended as advertised, and also an unadvertised portion, being the NE/4 of Section 15 in Township 17 South, Range 29 East.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning the extension of the Atoka Pool?

A I recommend that the pool be extended as advertised and also several unadvertised portions, those being the E/2 of the NW/4, and the W/2 of the NE/4 of Section 13, and the S/2 of Section 16, and the E/2 of the SE/4 of Section 17 in Township 18, Range 26 East.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning extension of the Cave Pool?

A I have. I recommend that it be extended as advertised, and also an unadvertised portion, that being the SW/4 of the SE/4 of Section 5 in Township 17 South, Range 29 East.

Q What are your recommendations concerning extension of the Dollarhide-Drinkard Pool?

A I recommend that it be extended as advertised.

Q Do you have any recommendations concerning extension of the E-K Queen Pool?

A Yes, sir, I have. I recommend that it be extended as advertised, and also an unadvertised portion, that being the W/2

of the SE/4 of Section 8 in Township 18, South, Range 34 East.

Q Do you have any further recommendations?

A No, I haven't.

Q Do you have any exhibits in this case?

A Yes, I have. I have Exhibits A through I, which I wish to submit to the Commission.

MR. COOLEY: I would like to offer Exhibits A through I reflecting the -- supporting the evidence concerning the creations and extensions as lettered in the documents A through I.

MR. PORTER: Without objection, the Exhibits will be admitted. Anyone have a question of Mr. Runyan? If not, the witness may be excused. Anyone else have any further comments in this case? If not, we will take the case under advisement.
