APPLICATION OF CONTINENTAL OIL COMPANY FOR A 160-ACRE NON-STANDARD GAS PRORATION UNIT IN THE BLINEBRY GAS POOL, LEA COUNTY, NEW MEXICO, IN EXCEPTION TO RULE 5 (a) OF THE SPECIAL RULES AND REGULATIONS OF THE BLINEBRY GAS POOL.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 17, 1957, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this /o day of May, 1957, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the application, the testimony and the evidence adduced, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this case and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the applicant is co-owner and operator of the W. C. Hawk "B-3" Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 3.
- (3) That Continental Oil Company is co-owner and operator of Lot 15, N/2 SE/4, and SE/4 SE/4 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico.
- (4) That the applicant proposes to dedicate Lot 15, N/2 SE/4, and SE/4 SE/4 of said Section 3 to its aforementioned W. C. Hawk "B-3" Well No. 3.
- (5) That approval of the applicant's proposed non-standard gas proration unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool will not cause waste nor impair correlative rights.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(1) That the application of Continental Oil Company for a 160-acre non-standard gas provation unit in the Blinebry Gas Pool

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consisting of Lot 15, N/2 SE/4 and SE/4 SE/4 of Section 3, Township 21 South, Range 37 East, NMPM, Lea County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby approved, and that the applicant's W. C. Hawk "B-3" Well No. 3, located 1980 feet from the South line and 1980 feet from the East line of said Section 3, be and the same is hereby designated as the unit well.

(2) That the applicant's aforementioned W. C. Hawk "B-3" Well No. 3, continue to be granted a 160-acre allowable provided an amended Form C-128 is filed with the Commission showing the change in acreage dedicated to the well.
