

Gentlemen:

Reference is made to your letter of June 4, 1957, concerning the Oil Conservation Commission's interpretation of the abovecaptioned order.

The Commission interprets Rule 3 (a) of Order R-1011 as being applicable only to those wells projected to or completed in the Kemnitz-Wolfcamp Pool after the effective date of the Rule, i.e.. June 1, 1957.

The Commission has consistently taken the position that a well, which was drilled in accordance with the Rules and Regulations in effect at the time it was commenced, is on an authorized location regardless of any subsequent change in Rules and Regulations.

Any well which was projected to or completed in the Kemnitz-Wolfcamp Pool prior to June 1, 1957, will be considered to be located in conformance with Rule 3 (a) of Order R-1011.

I hope that the foregoing will dispel any misgivings which you might have had concerning Order R-1011. If I can be of any further service, please do not hesitate to call upon me.


