APPLICATION

Now Comes Amerada Petroleum Corporation, Tulsa, Oklahoma, and alleges the following:

- 1. That this Commission heretofore has created, designated and defined the vertical and horizontal limits of the Justis Gas Pool, Lea County, New Mexico.
- 2. That Rule 5, the Special Rules and Regulations for the Justis Gas Pool, of Order No. R-586, as amended, provides that a standard proration unit for the purpose of producing gas from the Justis Gas Pool shall consist of between 158 and 162 contiguous surface acres substantially in the form of a square which shall be a legal subdivision (quarter section) of the U.S. Public Land Surveys.
- 3. That applicant has evidence to show that these special rules and regulations for the Justis Gas Pool should be amended to authorize the formation of standard gas proration units consisting of 320 acres, more or less.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that this Commission set this application for public hearing at the time and place to be fixed by the Commission, that due and proper notice thereof be given as required by Law, and that at the conclusion of said hearing this Commission enter its order authorizing the formation of 320 acre standard gas proration units for the Justis Gas Pool and amending or entering such other rules and regulations as the Commission deems necessary for the purposes herein stated.
