BASED ON EXPERIENCE, WE HONESTLY BELIEVE THAT PRORATION OF FLOODS IN STRIPPER FIELDS WILL RESULT IN AN INEFFICIENT RECOVERY MECHANISM WHICH WILL RESULT IN UNDERGROUND WASTE IN THE FORM OF LOWER ULTIMATE RECOVERIES THAN IF ALLOWED TO PRODUCE AT CAPACITY. RESULTING INEFFICIENCY IS DUE TO THE FACT THAT PHYSICAL CHARACTERISTICS OF THE RESERVOIR ROCK CANNOT BE VARIED TO CONFIRM WITH LIMITED OR PRORATED RATES OF PRODUCTION=

IN RE: CASE 1294, STATEMENT OF SUN OIL COMPANY =

SUN OIL COMPANY IS AN OPERATOR IN SEVERAL FIELDS IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO AND AS SUCH HAS A VITAL INTEREST, BOTH PRESENT AND FUTURE, IN THE PROBLEMS AND THE POLICIES OF PRORATION AND PRODUCTION IN THIS STATE. WITH REFERENCE TO THE APPLICATION OF AMBASSADOR OIL CORPORATION THERE IS NO QUESTION BUT THAT AN OPERATOR, KNOWING THAT PRORATION IS IN EFFECT AND WITH ADVANCED KNOWLEDGE OF THE OIL ALLOWABLES AVAILABLE TO HIM, CAN MAKE THE NECESSARY COMPENSATIONS OR ADJUSTMENTS IN WATER INJECTION OPERATIONS TO INSURE THAT HE WILL ACHIEVE THE GREATEST ECONOMIC OIL RECOVERY. THIS FACT HAS BEEN TACITLY RECOGNIZED BY THE COMMISSION IN THE CAPROCK-QUEEN POOL BY ORDER R--1128 DATED FEBRUARY 12, 1958, WHICH CONTAINED THE PROVISION, "THAT THE APPLICANT SHALL REGULATE THE INJECTION OF WATER INTO THE ABOVE-DESCRIBED WELLS SO THAT THE PRODUCTION FROM THE WELLS AFFECTED BY THE INJECTION PROJECT CAN BE PRORATED WITHOUT CAUSING WASTE." =

WE WOULD NOT LIKE TO SEE ANY INDIVIDUAL PROJECT GRANTED A POTENTIALLY LARGE SHARE OF THE AVAILABLE MARKET BY MEANS OF UNRESTRICTED PRODUCTION AND FEEL THAT APPROVAL OF THIS APPLICATION FOR CAPACITY PRODUCTION COULD BE DETRIMENTAL TO SOUND CONSERVATION IN NEW MEXICO=


