



IN RE: CASE 1294, STATEMENT OF SUN OIL COMPANY = SUN OIL COMPANY IS AN OPERATOR IN SEVERAL FIELDS IN THE STATE OF NEW MEXICO AND AS SUCH HAS A VITAL INTEREST, BOTH PRESENT AND FUTURE, IN THE PROBLEMS AND THE POLICIES OF PRORATION AND PRODUCTION IN THIS STATE.
