COMES NOW, El Paso Natural Gas Products Company, hereinafter called "Applicant", and alleges and states:

1. That Applicant is the owner and operator of oil and gas leases covering Section 30, Township 24 North, Range 8 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

2. That heretofore, Applicant has drilled its Sapp #1 Well on said section at a location 1,450 feet from the south line and 965 feet from the east line of said Section 30, as indicated by the plat which is attached hereto and made a part hereof.

3. That said well was originally staked as a standard wildcat gas well location, but was subsequently completed as an oil well in the Gallup Formation in an undesignated oil pool.

4. That this Application is made for the prevention of waste and the drilling of unnecessary wells and the granting of the Order prayed for herein will not prejudice correlative rights.

5. Applicant seeks an order, pursuant to Rule 104 (b)(2) approving said well in said location for the production of oil.

6. No other interested party is known to the Applicant.

WHEREFORE, Applicant respectfully requests that an Order be issued setting this matter down for hearing in the City of Aztec, New Mexico, on August 20, 1957, before an Examiner, and that notice thereof be given as required by law, and that upon final hearing, an Order be issued approving said well in said location for the production of oil.
