Supplementing our program for the formation of nonstandard pro-ration units and unorthodox well locations, which was the subject of an Examiner Hearing in Farmington, New Mexico, on September 11, 1957, we furnish the following as legal descriptions for the various nonstandard pro-ration units:

The above legal descriptions for Township 31 North, Range 7 West, were taken from the Federal Survey Plat filed in the United States Survey General's Office at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on November 13, 1917, and accepted by the Government Land Office on November 24, 1917, and the legal descriptions for Township 32 North, Range 7 West, were taken from the Federal Survey Plat filed in the Survey General's Office at Santa Fe, New Mexico, on November 4, 1882.
