Gentlemen:

This letter is written for and on behalf of
I & W HOT OIL, INC., a New Mexico corporation, with its
principal place of business at Artesia, New Mexico. The
Officers of this corporation, are:

JAMES M. WINDHAM, President

LOWELL M. IRBY, Vice-President

CLARA WINDHAM, Secretary-Treasurer

all of whom are residents of Artesia, New Mexico. This
corporation desires to make application under Commission
Rules 311 and 312 for permits required for cleaning tank
bottoms and for a treating plant, and in support thereof,
states as follows:

1. That the applicant is now the owner of a port-
able hot oil unit and tank truck which will meet all of the
requirements of the State of New Mexico for the transportation
over the highways of the State of New Mexico, which equip-
ment will be used in cleaning, heating, treating and processing
tank bottom emulsion and other waste oils with the capacity
of 100 barrels per hour.

2. The applicant will place at each location the
necessary settling and storage tanks to be used in the clean-
ing, heating, treating and processing of the tank bottom
emulsion and other waste oils, said locations being set out
hereinbelow.


3. It is proposed by the applicant that if this
permit is granted the location of the cleaning, heating,
treating and processing plants will be on (a) Malco Pipeline

approximately twelve miles East of Artesia, New Mexico,
(b) on Texas-New Mexico Pipeline at Loco Hills, New Mexico,
(3) on Texas-New Mexico Pipeline at Maljamar, New Mexico,
and at such other places on pipelines within the State of
New Mexico where cleaning, heating, treating and processing
of tank bottom emulsions and other waste oils is required.
The Oil Conservation Commission to be notified of the exact
location and approval obtained before actual installation is
made.

4. The applicant stands ready, willing and able
to file with the Commission a \$25,000 surety bond, which
will be acceptable to the Commission.

The applicant would appreciate notice of the time
and place of hearing and hereby extends an invitation for
the hearing to be held in Artesia, New Mexico. If the hear-
ing of the Commission is to be held in Artesia, New Mexico,
please notify the writer and he will secure the place for
the hearing and make the necessary arrangements.
