
Re: Statewide Proration Order No. A-97

Dear Mr. Porter:

In behalf of Lowry, et al., operating account, it is requested that an emergency exception be granted to the provisions of the above captioned order, in so far as it affects oil production from the South Blanco-Tocito Oil Pool, Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, and that hearing be set for consideration of special rules affecting said pool.

Basis for this request is the pressure maintenance program now underway in the South Blanco-Tocito Pool, which has been heretofore approved by the Commission; the 80-acre spacing heretofore approved by the Commission; and other orders entered by the Commission affecting said pool. Upon hearing, the operator will be prepared to offer testimony in support of a minimum pool allowable of one thousand barrels per day, and other testimony and evidence to support proposals for special rules for the pool.
