That said basic lease when developed will have thirteen oil wells 18 producing from the Grayburg-San Andres Formation at approximately 4500 feet; 19 that said development will be undertaken and accomplished by the applicant as 20 operator thereof. 21 3. That because of the common interest in and the ownership of the 22 wells upon the basic lease and the economic savings that can be obtained from 23 such common tankage, an Order granting exception to OCC Rule 309 would be 24 proper in the premises; that applicant is ready, willing, and able to provide 25 and install such equipment as the Commission may require to accurately de-26 termine the production from each well at reasonable times and intervals. 27 WHEREFORE, applicant prays that this matter be set down for hearing 28 before this Commission or one of its Examiners; that due notice thereof be
