THE APPLICATION OF THE CIL CONSERVATION COMMISSION UPON ITS OWN MOTION FOR AN ORDER CREATING AND EXTENDING CERTAIN POOLS IN SAN JUAN AND RIC ARRIBA COUNTIES, NEW MEXICO.

ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on March 13, 1958, at Santa Fe, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this $25^{\frac{1}{10}}$ day of March, 1958, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That there is need for the creation of a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, for the production of gas from the Fruitland formation, said pool to bear the designation Kutz-Fruitland Pool. Said Kutz-Fruitland Pool was discovered by R & G Drilling Company Schlosser Well No. 25, located in the NW/4 SE/4 Section 27, Township 28 North, Range 11 West, NMPM. It was completed August 30, 1956. The top of the perforations is at 1330 feet.
- (3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Gavilan-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool, both in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to the Kutz-Farmington Pool, the Aztec-Fruitland Pool, the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool, the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, and to the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, all in San Juan County, New Mexico, and to the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool and the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool both in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico.

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IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That a new pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, classified as a gas pool for Fruitland production, be and the same is hereby created and designated as the Kutz-Fruitland Pool, consisting of the following described area:

(b) That the Kutz-Farmington Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(c) That the Aztec-Fruitland Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(d) That the Aztec-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(e) That the South Blanco-Pictured Cliffs Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

Section 30: All Section 32: All Section 33: All Section 34: W/2

(f) That the Gavilan-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(g) That the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

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(h) That the Blanco Mesaverde Pool in San Juan and Rio Arriba Counties, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include there in:

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 12 WEST, NMPM Section 30: All

(i) That the Bisti-Lower Gallup Cil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 10 WEST, NMPM Section 28: 5/2

TOWNSHIP 25 NORTH, RANGE 11 WEST, NMPM Section 15: SW/4
Section 24: N/2

(j) That the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

(k) That the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool in San Juan County, New Mexico, as heretofore classified, defined, and described, be and the same is hereby extended to include therein:

TOWNSHIP 31 NORTH, RANGE 14 WEST, NMPM Section 17: NW/4

IT IS FURTHER ORDERED:

That the effective date of this order and all the creations and extensions included herein shall be April 1, 1958.
