Reference is made to your application dated May 17, 1968, for administrative approval of an exception to Rule 303 (a) of the Commission Rules and Regulations to permit the commingling of Corbin-Queen and Maljamar Grayburg-San Andres production on your Wyatt A Lease which comprises the S/2 S/2 of Sections 33 and 34, Township 17 South, Range 33 East and all of Section 5, Township 18 South, Range 33 East, Lea County, New Mexico, allocating the production on the basis of periodic well tests. It is our understanding that the production from both peols on said lease is of marginal nature.

By the authority vested in me under the provisions of Rule 303 (b) of the Commission Rules and Regulations, you are hereby authorized to commingle the production from the aforesaid pools on said lease in the above-described manner, provided however, that the installation shall be sperated in accordance with the provisions of the Commission "Manual for the Installation and Operation of Commingling Facilities," and provided further, that you shall notify the Commission at such time as any well in either of the aforesaid pools is capable of top allowable production.

Commission Order No. R-1279, dated Movember 5, 1958, which authorized the commingling of production from the Wyatt Mos. 1, 2, 3, and 6 Wells on this lease is hereby put in abeyance.
