

It has been called to our attention that Case No(4047/will be brought before the New Mexico Oil Conservation Commission on February 19, 1969 to consider the disposal of salt brines into the Lea County areas known as Laguna Plata, Laguna Gatuna and Laguna Tonto, all located in western Lea County, New Mexico.

Continental American Royalty Company owns substantial potash leases, with U. S. Potash & Chemical Co. designated the operator, on a portion of Laguna Gatuna and in the vicinity of Laguna Tonto. In these areas there is a very definite possibility that economic minerals in the form of Sodium Sulphate (Na₂SO₄) and possibly other minerals exist in economic quantities that must be carefully evaluated for the proper conservation of mineral resources. It is strongly felt that the discharge of salt brines into these Lagoon areas could very materially adversely contaminate the potential economic value of commercial minerals that may be in place in the Lagoon areas.

Therefore, U. S. Potash & Chemical Co. strongly objects to any approval consideration for Case No. 4047 due to the fact it is imperative in our opinion that additional facts, information and technical data must be secured concerning the presence of commercial minerals in the Lagoon areas prior to any decision.

The additional time of at least one (1) year is respectfully recommended and needed for procurement of facts and data so as this information can be capably evaluated in keeping with proper conservation of potential commercial mineral resources.



APPEAL FROM THE BUREAU OF LAND MANAGEMENT

E. W. Douglass and his wife Cleo Douglass have filed separate appeals to the Secretary from a decision dated August 1, 1960, whereby the Acting Director, Bureau of Land Management, affirmed two decisions of the manager, Santa Fe land office, dated March 31, 1958, and March 28, 1958, respectively, which rejected their applications for sodium prospecting permits.

Concerning application NM 042594, the manager determined that on the date of filing, some of the lands described therein was embraced in potash lease NM 013298-A, issued February 24, 1953, and the remaining land was in the Potash Mines Area (Eddy and Lea Counties). See Secretary's order of October 16, 1951, 16 F. R. 10669.

Relative to application NM 042595 (as amended), the manager determined that on the date of filing, all of the lands described therein were embraced in one of three potash leases, NM 011776, issued May 6, 1953 (modified October 4, 1954), Las Cruces 068397, issued May 6, 1955, and NM 013298-B, dated February 24, 1953.

He concluded, as to both applications, that in view of the provisions of section 4 of the act of February 7, 1927 (30 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 284), and section 24 of the act of February 25, 1920, as amended (30 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 262), "concurrent permits and leases to mine for potassium and sodium upon the same lands are not granted."

Acting under and pursuant to the provisions of the act of June 25, 1910, as amended (43 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 141), the President, on March 11, 1926, executed an "Order of Withdrawal, Potash Reserve No. 6, New Mexico No. 1", covering 7,418,437 acres of land, which was amended June 8, 1929, by Presidential "Order of Withdrawal, Potash Reserve He. 7, New Mexico No. 2" to include an additional 1,874,423 acres, withdrawing the lands it covered from settlement, location, sale or entry, and reserving them for dissolfication and in aid of legislation. All of the lands described in the appellants' two applications were contained within the areas described in the orders.

Section 23 of the set of February 25, 1920, as emended (30 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 261), or nominal the Secretary, at last custoretion, to grant prospecting percents for (emong other minerals) nitrates of sodium, and section 24 of that set (30 U. S. C., 1990 ed., sec. 262) provides:

"That upon showing to the satisfaction of the Secretary of the Interior that valuable deposits of one of the substances enumerated in section 23 hereof have been discovered by the permittee within the area covered by his permit <u>and</u> that such land is chiefly valuable therefor, the permittee shall be entitled to a lesse * * *." (Emphasis added.)

The act of February 7, 1927, as amended (30 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 281 <u>et seq.</u>), authorizes the Secretary of the Interior, in his discretion, to issue permits or leases to prospect for or mine potassium deposits in the public lands.

Section 4 of that act, as amended (30 U. S. C., 1958 ed., sec. 284), provides in part as follows:

"That if the interests of the Government and of the lessee will be subserved thereby, potassium leases may include covenants providing for the development by the lessee of * * * nitrates of sodium, * * * associated with the potassium deposits leased, * * *."

It is the Department's policy, in view of the provisions of section 4 of the act of February 7, 1927, and section 24 of the act of February 25, 1920, <u>supra</u>, not to grant concurrent permits and leases to mine for potassium and sodium upon the same lands. Where lands are more valuable for potassium than for sodium, it is also the Department's policy to authorize the taking of potassium only under a potassium lease. <u>Dorothy P. Soeth</u>, A-24408 (November 12, 1946); <u>Frank M. Darrow</u>, A-25185 (June 9, 1948).

All the lands applied for by the appellants are either in leases issued or applications filed prior to the date of their applications and are in an area long held to be valuable for potassium. Thus in view of the Department's policy to avoid conclusions between the rights of sodium and potassium lessees it was proper to reject appellants' applications.

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In the absence of any overriding public interest, the possibility that the deposits may occur separately, as the appellants allege, does not warrant a departure from this policy because it would be difficult to assure that there would be no interference of the one with the other.


Therefore, the decision of the Director. Bureau of Land Management, is affirmed.




