This is to advise that Mr. H. K. Riddle has elected to proceed under Option 1 of the above referenced order as shown on the enclosed plat.

In compliance with paragraph 4 of Order No. R-1301 we submit herewith a copy of a pooling agreement between H. K. Riddle and John W. Sullivan covering Lots 3, 4, 9, and 10 of Section 18 and Lots 3, 4, 9, and 10 of Section 19, all in Township 26 North, Range 13 West, N.M.P.M., San Juan County, New Mexico.

The foregoing option is exercised, however, with the understanding that Mr. Riddle will be permitted to rededicate the acreage involved and proceed under Option 2 of Order No. R-1301 in the event he desires to do so after having drilled the well

provided for in Option 1. The foregoing is in accordance with an agreement reached between the undersigned and Mr. Nutter by telephone conversation on June 25, 1959.
