We are in receipt of your letter of February 15, 1958 wherein you stated that you wanted to communitize the above captioned lease with our acreage adjoining you to the east.

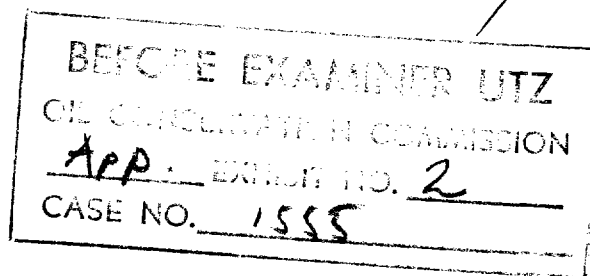


