ORDER OF THE COMMISSION

BY THE COMMISSION:

This cause came on for hearing at 9 o'clock a.m. on April 15, 1959, at Hobbs, New Mexico, before the Oil Conservation Commission of New Mexico, hereinafter referred to as the "Commission."

NOW, on this day of April, 1959, the Commission, a quorum being present, having considered the testimony presented and the exhibits received at said hearing, and being fully advised in the premises,

FINDS:

- (1) That due public notice having been given as required by law, the Commission has jurisdiction of this cause and the subject matter thereof.
- (2) That the designation of the Otero-Graneros Dakota Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, should be changed to the Otero-Dakota Pool to conform with the provisions of Order No. R-1287.
- (3) That there is need for certain extensions to the Tapacito-Pictured Cliffs Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, to the Angels Peak-Gallup Oil Pool, the Bisti-Lower Gallup Oil Pool, the Horseshoe-Gallup Oil Pool, the Verde-Gallup Oil Pool, and the Angels Peak-Dakota Pool all in San Juan County, New Mexico, and to the Blanco-Mesaverde Pool in Rio Arriba and San Juan Counties, New Mexico.

IT IS THEREFORE ORDERED:

(a) That the name of the Otero-Graneros Dakota Pool in Rio Arriba County, New Mexico, be and the same is hereby changed to the Otero-Dakota Pool.
